5-FOOT TREE PRO MIRACLE TUBE TREE SHELTERS

Tree Pro Miracle Tubes are one of the many effective reforestation aides available to foster successful tree plantings or assist in the natural regeneration of trees. These shelters are easy to install, maintain and remove.

STEP 1

Larger trees, especially those where natural regeneration is to be fostered, may need to be pruned in order to allow for proper installation of the tree shelter.



STEP 2

Slide the Tree Pro Miracle Tube tree shelter, collar side up, over the seedling or young tree. You may need to bundle long branches in one hand while sliding the shelter over the branches.

STEP 3

Work the shelter back and forth in a circular motion to insure that the bottom edge of the shelter is worked into the ground at least one inch.



STEP 4

Slide the hardwood stake, PVC pipe or other stake material through the black tie straps.

STEP 5

Drive the hardwood stake, PVC pipe or other stake material into the ground at least 5 inches.



STEP 6

Tighten the black ties by pulling on the end.



STEP 7

Stretch the protective bird netting and place over the top of the tree shelter.

On-going Maintenance of Tree Pro Miracle Tubes

Tree Pro Miracle Tube tree shelters were designed to be as durable and maintenance-free as possible. However, once a year, usually in autumn, loosen ties and lift the Tree Pro Miracle Tube to remove any ground vegetation which may have grown inside the tree shelter. Also, remove any mice or rodents which may have started nesting in tube. Check stakes and replace any which may have broken. Remove bird netting when tree is about to emerge from top of the tree shelter.
